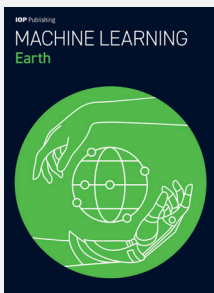
The following open access journals can be added to transformative agreements from January 2027:

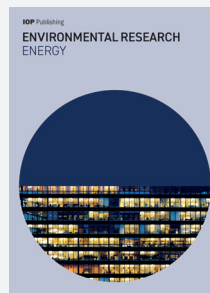

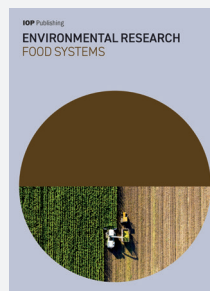

*Environmental Research: Food Systems* covers all aspects of the food system from production to consumption and from local to global.

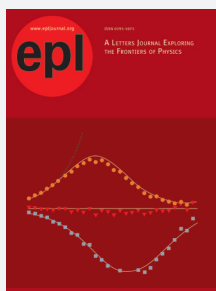

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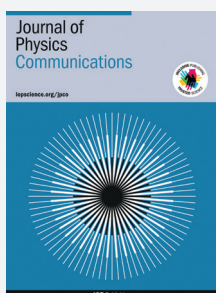
## EPL transferring to Oxford University Press in January 2027

## Journal of Physics Communications to close at the end of 2026



Since 2017, we've been proud to work with the physics community to develop *Journal of Physics Communications* (JPCO) and publish a range of high-quality research.

After careful review, it has been decided that the journal hasn't reached the scale needed to support it sustainably in the long term. Therefore, it has been decided to cease publication of JPCO at the end of 2026.
